Work Schedule

- You'll work outside 4 days per week, 10+/- hour shifts daily during daylight savings (which offers you a 3-day weekend most weeks!) The remainder of the year will be 5 days per week, 8+/- hours per day. All daily work is weather permitting. You will start at 7:00 am. Occasional Saturday work is possible. Your workday is finished when the jobsite is clean, all tools are put back in their proper places, and paperwork is complete.
- We provide transportation from our shop in Willow Grove to job sites. You'll drive or ride in a work truck from the shop to the job sites.

Responsibilities:

- Leads, directs, and performs hands-on hardscape construction work with a crew of 2-3 members daily.
- Responsible for understanding the flow of a hardscape project and efficiently using staff on a wide variety of projects.
- Execute hardscape installations, such as patios, walkways, retaining walls, firepits, outdoor kitchens and other outdoor living areas, ensuring adherence to design specifications and project timelines.

- Contribute to our safety culture by wearing assigned Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

- Reliable transportation to the shop.
- Valid driver's license with PA Med Card preferred.
- Ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs. & walk long distances.
- Able to pass a pre-employment background check and drug test.
